

The summer final half term is well under way and I am pleased to say the new hall project has begun and is all going to schedule. The hall should be completed ready for the start of term in September. We are also having the ground floor of the school decorated over the summer holidays so everything will look lovely and bright when the children return to school. I am also pleased to inform you that Leeds City Council has appointed a road crossing patrol officer, Mrs Chowdri, (lollipop lady) who will be starting work on 6th September. Mrs Chowdri also works as a lunchtime supervisor in school and so knows the children very well. The crossing will be situated on Sandringham Approach.

The governing body have reviewed our charging and remissions policy. School dinner charges for children in KS2 will be £2.20 per day from September. Musical tuition fees will be £60 per term. Keyboard club will remain at £50 per term. Please look out for a school dinner letter which we are sending out on 20th June. The dinner letter explains a new banding system which will be introduced in September and has a dinner options sheet for you to fill in and return to school.

Our large 90 cohort will be moving into the main part of school and will be based in the old Year 1 and the current Year 1 class bases. The old Year 1 room is being redecorated and refurbished in the summer holidays. The three classes will be in close proximity to each other and will continue to work and plan together as a team. You will be notified of your child's new class in their school report which will be sent home on July 14th.

Sadly, we are saying goodbye to another much loved member of our team this summer. Mrs Elaine Taylor has worked in school for many years as a Learning Mentor and then Teaching Assistant. We will greatly miss her vast experience, dedication and passion for learning.

School attendance continues to be high at 96%.
