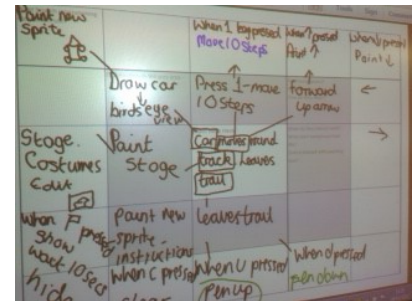
These pictures show some of our new Computing equipment in school.
