The Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

I/We shall try to:

- see that my/our child attends school regularly, on time and in school uniform, and with appropriate equipment
- let the school know about any information, concerns or problems that might affect my/our child's health, work or behaviour
- discuss and agree strategies with the school to help my/our child if they experience difficulties
- support my/our child with homework
- attend parents' evenings and discussions about my/our child's progress
- ensure prompt payment of any monies due to school
- not take my/our child out of school for holidays during term time. I understand that I may be issued with a fixed penalty fine if I do so.

I/We give permission for:

- the recording and photography of school events by school, for purposes such as internal displays, records etc.
- the recording and photography of school events by school for the school website,
- the recording and photography of school events by authorised invited organisations working with the school eg. Play in a Day, football matches etc
- our child's data to be passed onto their relevant high school

I / We will support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour by:

- setting a positive example to all children

The following are types of behaviour which are totally inconsistent with the way we expect children and parents to behave:

- confrontations between parents, or parents and other parents' children or staff
- undermining the efforts and professional judgement of staff
- engaging in inappropriate actions or comments
- lack of adherence to the school equality policy. At Highfield Primary, we understand equity to mean treating everyone fairly and with dignity by valuing their individual characteristics such as their age, disability, gender, identity, race, sex, religion, beliefs, sexual orientation and socio-economic circumstances
- actions or the lack of thought which endanger others' safety- especially driving and parking practices
- lack due consideration and courtesy to others

The school will endeavour to:

- make Highfield a happy place to be
- provide the children with an education in line with the National Curriculum and achieve appropriate levels of attainment
- discuss and agree strategies with parent(s) / guardian(s) in respect of any problem with their child's work or behaviour
- encourage, assist and reward children to do their best at all times so that they may achieve their full potential
- set and monitor homework
- inform and discuss with parent(s) / guardian(s) their child's progress at regular intervals
- provide a secure and caring environment
- keep parent(s) / guardian(s) informed about school activities through regular newsletters and the website

Each child will be expected to follow the school rules

- support your child's learning to help them achieve their best at all times and reach their full potential
- encourage your child to keep to the school rules and act in a responsible manner
- support and develop appropriate strategies to deal with any special needs which arise
